The following is the action we agreed upon during our Thursday, March 5th meeting.

A. Statement on Laos

Mr. Nofziger suggested that the pertinent portions of the Geneva Agreements be extracted, reproduced, and distributed to the press for their information and use.

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B. Senator Fulbright's Appearance on MEET THE PRESS,
Sunday, March 8th

Mr. Haldeman suggested that this program be monitored very closely so that we can get an immediate reaction to anything the Senator might say. Also, we should try to get someone on one of the Sunday evening news shows to rebut Fulbright.

C. Executive Office Reorganization Message, Friday,
March 13th

It was suggested that, in addition to Mr. Ash, someone else -- perhaps Mr. Thayer -- should be present at the press briefing following release of the message.

Mrs. White indicated that MEET THE PRESS wanted Mr. Ehrlichman or Mr. Haldeman to appear on the show and it was suggested that instead maybe we could get Mr. Harlow or Governor Connelly on the show.
